

CONTRACTORS

- Must have Occupational Tax Certificate (OTC, business license) issued by Albany/Dougherty County Treasury
- Structural, HVAC, Plumbing, and Electrical Contractors must hold a State Certification & Local OTC
- Contractors performing structural repairs must obtain a building permit
- Contractors paid to dispose of debris should not place debris on right of way, debris must be disposed properly
- Must comply with all Federal, State and Local laws.

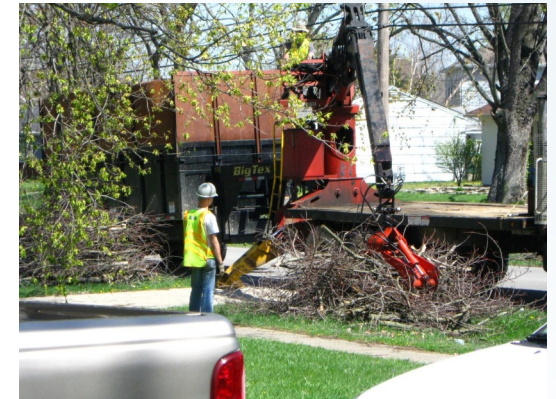

STORM DEBRIS SEPARATION PLACEMENT & DISPOSAL

STORM DEBRIS

- Keep debris piles to a size manageable for pick up
 - Do not place whole trees on right of way
 - Keep debris separated into appropriate piles for pick up
- ⇒ **Tree debris/vegetation**
- ⇒ **Household Furniture**
- ⇒ **Construction debris**
- ⇒ **Appliances**
- Household garbage should be placed in 90-gallon Polly cart and put out on regular pick up days
 - Household garbage should not be placed in bags on right of way
 - **DO NOT PLACE DEBRIS IN ROADWAY OR STREETS**

STORM DEBRIS

DO NOT stack or lean debris on trees, street signs or power poles

DO NOT put leaves or yard debris in garbage bags

Contractors must dispose of construction & demolition debris

Place debris on edge of your property and right of way
